### DIGIVID News

#### **DIGIVIDget**

We are happy to announce that the implementation of the DIGIVIDget is finished (some polishing activities will be done in the background).

We have now implemented the following Modules in German and English:

#### **Learning and Training Activities (LTTAs)**

As planned, we have conducted in Austria, Germany and Norway our learning and training activities.



## **LTTA in Austria**

In Austria, we were able to recruit 11 participants via the “Private Pädagogische Hochschule Augustinum” and conducted our workshop series with in-service teachers providing the following content:

- Workshop 1 (5.10.2022) - Einführungs-Workshop: This workshop was held together with the participants from Austria and Germany, to give an introduction about the project, to introduce the DIGIVIDget and to set the stage for the evaluation. Afterwards, the Austrian participants continued with the topics about “Sie können Kriterien anwenden, um Informationen kritisch auf Ihren Wahrheitsgehalt und ihre Qualität hin zu beurteilen”. In addition we gave an introduction regarding basic understanding of general terms used in the Internet (e.g. Browser, Cloud, ...)
- Workshop 2 (12.10.2022): File Sharing & Data security: In this workshop, we presented content about the following topics: File Sharing, which was about how to share files securely over the internet. The second topic was about data privacy and security.
- Workshop 3: (19.10.2022): Medien Sozialisation and Gefahren im Internet. The first topic was about how digital media influences teachers, students, pupils and in the second topic we made the participants aware of dangers or pitfalls that could occur while surfing the Internet.
- Workshop 4 (9.11.2022): Digitale Barrierefreiheit: In this workshop we talked about digital accessibility on the web and the accessibility of digital learning materials and tools, respectively. Moreover, participants got to know technologies that support inclusive teaching and learning in schools and universities.
- Workshop 5 (16.11.2022): Copyright, Licenses and OER: In the last topic, we presented our participants content about copyright and law, creative common licenses and what open educational resources are.

In all workshops (but the last one), the participants received some homework, which they had to “prepare” for the subsequent workshop.

Additionally, we conducted a common reflection session at the beginning of each workshop (but the first one) was held. The goal was to reflect together with the participants about the homeworks and what they were able to put into practice regarding the previous workshop content..

We also prepared 2 questionnaires, which we sent out in the first and the last workshop. Overall, the feedback we received was very, very good and all participants were very happy with the knowledge they gained through our LTTA..

## **LTTAs in Germany**

In Germany, also 5 LTTA sessions took place. The final session of the LTTA at TU Dresden did lead to a very insightful discussion regarding possibilities and requirements for the implementation of the DIGIVID training that’s why I like to report briefly in the newsletter. Foremost, a technical discussion regarding possibilities and requirements for the implementation of the DIGIVID training was held via ZOOM with the Trainer, Prof. Dr. Thomas Köhler, the Director of the TU Dresden Center for Open Digital Innovation and Participation.

### **LTTA in Norway**

In Norway the learning activities were organized as single workshops with in- and pre-service teachers in schools, and with teaching assistants at the university level. Workshops with teaching assistants were conducted in cooperation with Excited, the Norwegian Center for Excellence in IT education (<https://www.ntnu.edu/excited>). At the beginning of the workshops, participants received a brief introduction of the project and of DIGIVIDget. Participants had then the possibility to familiarize with the system by performing a set of predefined tasks and navigate different content. Finally, participants had the possibility to discuss their experience with the system and the relevance of the curriculum for them.

### **User studies**

In Austria, in the wintersemester 2022/23 36 students of the Master's program "Inclusive Education", 23 primary school teacher students (Bachelor's program) and 4 secondary school teacher students (Master's program) learned the basics of digital accessibility and assistive technologies with the help of the DIGIVIDget.

Follow-up user studies are in planning.
